Trace the path with your finger to help Little Red Riding Hood find her way safely to Grandma's house.



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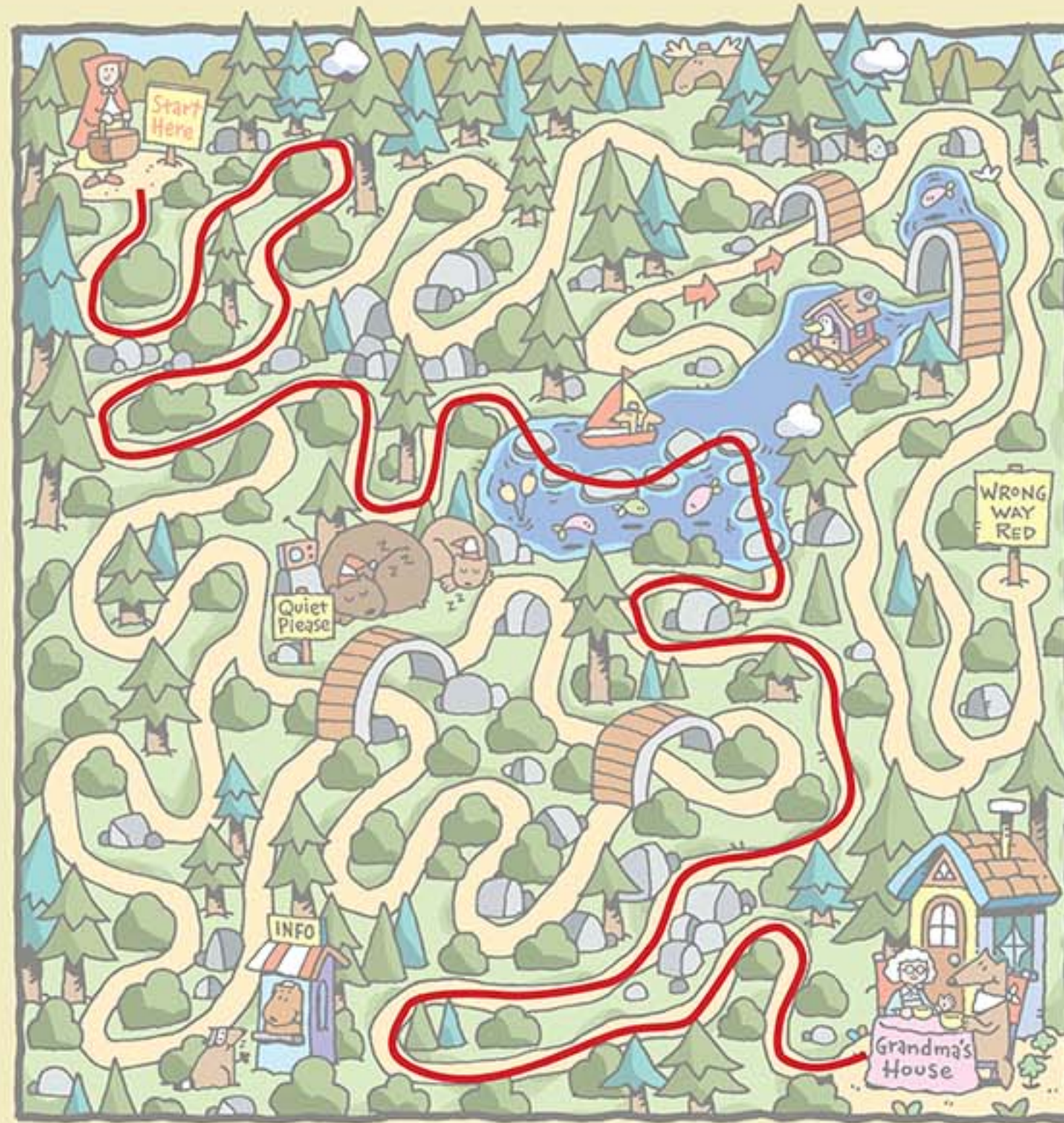
Forest Friends
