

## **Educator Guide**

#### **DISCUSSION**

Ask these questions to the class as a whole or have students discuss in small groups. These questions encourage students to think about both positive and negative methods of communication, as well as overcoming challenges at the personal and community level.

- 1. The mother dragon tells the little fire dragon to be brave on her journey, and that she knows the little fire dragon can do it! What is something that you tell yourself to stay strong and positive?
- 2. The mother dragon's advice was a big help to the little fire dragon during her journey to relight the sun. Have you ever received advice that helped you through a difficult time?
- 3. The villagers were frightened of the little fire dragon when she was trying to help them. What is something you could say to the villagers to help them understand the situation and ease their fear?
- 4. It was hard for the little fire dragon to carry on when the villagers were frightened of her, but she knew what she had to do to help them. Has there ever been a time when you helped others, even when it was difficult?


