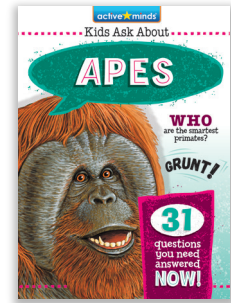

## Did you know?

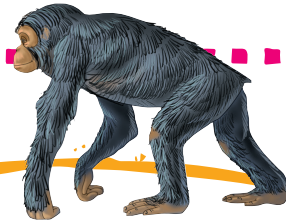
### Orangutans

will sometimes chime in when the adults sing duets with their mates.

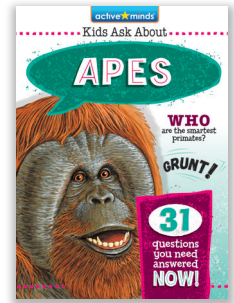


### The large groups
